Our collective generosity and actions have led to changing the course of the lives of children and generations to come forever. Together we provide education, a tool to overcome poverty. 
Incentive Students

Our Incentives Program, serving Elementary School children, inspires young learners by promoting education, creativity, and healthy habits. Through homework clubs, tutoring, and activities like literacy workshops, arts and crafts, and learning essential skills such as proper dental care, we empower children to thrive academically and personally.

As an exciting reward, participants enjoy a memorable field trip to the beach and celebrate at the annual Christmas Fiesta in December. This year, 350 children are benefiting from the program, and your support helps make it all possible. Together, we can continue to nurture their growth and bright futures!

Total number of students on scholarship has grown in the last few years from 154 students served in 2017 to having 250 Becarios for the 2024-25 year, and 20 additional children on a wait list.




Fátima Esmeralda Quintero Ramírez | Architecture
